This certificate demonstrates your participation in the 6th annual Beyond Silos symposium. This event featured health care and advocacy leaders pioneering advancements in transformative collaboration across the health and domestic violence sectors to improve survivor health and access.

Learning objectives included: 1) Explore critical shifts in policy and funding at the local, county, and state level, and their impacts on domestic violence, health, and housing services across Los Angeles County; 2) Identify opportunities to apply survivor-centered, intersectional perspectives to service delivery and navigation, partnership development, and funding approaches to support sustainability amid uncertainty; 3) Apply cross-sector strategies to navigate evolving support systems and leverage funding opportunities (including CalAIM and evolving housing pathways) in order to sustain and strengthen survivor access to coordinated, trauma-informed care; 4) Map existing DV and health care partnerships to identify assets, strengthen collaboration, replicate effective partnership models, and expand networks of care; and 5) Engage in opportunities for restorative, healing-centered practices and self-care that support workforce resilience, prevent burnout, and sustain the capacity of service providers navigating ongoing systems change.
