CareConnect

- Centers survivor consent, including the ability to secure and revoke consent
- Incorporates provider feedback and best-practices
- Complies with Violence Against Women Act's confidentiality provisions
- Allows for both identified and anonymous referrals
- Builds in flexibility that prioritizes only capturing relevant information from the survivor (not all questions are mandatory)
- Makes referrals visible, trackable, and actionable
- Supports intentional, trauma-informed way to share information among providers

WHAT IS CARECONNECT?

CareConnect is a secure referral and resource-management platform designed to help providers and advocates connect survivors of domestic violence, human trafficking, and sexual assault to services. It supports referrals for shelter, housing, legal advocacy, counseling, and other critical resources while centering survivor consent and safety.

WHY THIS PLATFORM IS DIFFERENT

Many providers have experienced systems that add steps without adding value. CareConnect was designed with those lessons in mind.

WHY IT IS WORTH IT

Using CareConnect helps:

- Reduce the number of times survivors must retell their story
- Improve the accuracy of referrals
- Prevent missed connections and dead ends
- Strengthen coordination across agencies
- Create a clearer picture of where services exist and where gaps remain

This is work that moves toward a real coordination of care.
